

A Message From Rabbi Gradofsky

The Yizkor service, in which we ask God to remember our departed loved ones, begins, with a very challenging question. The service begins by quoting two verses from Psalm 144: “*Lord, what is man that you know him; son of man, that you should think of him? Man is like a breath; his days are like a passing shadow.*” (v. 3-4)

It seems that these verses introduce an ironic truth about the Yizkor service. In remembering our loved ones, we come in touch with our own mortality. At the same time, our remembering our loved ones attests to the fact that their presence in this world has stretched beyond their lifetime.

Like us, our departed loved ones asked themselves what their legacy would be. We perform a great act of *chesed* (kindness) by perpetuating their memory.

As we recite the Yizkor service, we remember the indelible mark that our loved ones left on our lives. As we pray in their memory, we rekindle our love for them. Their days on this Earth were all too brief. And yet they touched our lives so meaningfully and helped shape who we are today. We pray that we have the opportunity to touch the lives of others in the same way, so that we may carry on our legacy, along with the legacy of our loved ones, even beyond our own days.
